Health Kits are a tangible way to meet the physical needs of those in our community. CBC has a goal of 300 kits (150 to go on the associational mission trip to Cleveland and 150 for the Truck Stop Ministry). Each kit contains 1 toothbrush (*factory sealed*), 1 tube of toothpaste (*6 oz. or larger*), 1 bar of soap (*4 oz – 6 oz*), 1 washcloth, 1 bath towel, and 1 comb; all items are to be placed in a 2-gallon Ziploc type bag and turned in to CBC by May 1.
