Operation Christmas Child

February, the month dedicated to showing **Love** to others, is the perfect time to kick off 2017 OCC, to start **Sharing the Love of Jesus** with children and their families here and abroad. Our shoeboxes show them the **Love of Jesus** from strangers.

This month, one can find all sorts of items that show love – *stuffed animals, toys, games, pencils w/hearts*. Purchase extra Valentines, sign “Jesus Loves You” and your name, put the cards in a zip-lock bag, and place in the collection box inside the Mallie Alderman SS classroom or hang on the doorknob of the O.C.C. room (*room off of Annie DuRant SS classroom*).

Please note: due to custom regulations, we can no longer include toothpaste or any candy in our boxes.

If you don't shop, you can donate money, which will be used to purchase items for the shoeboxes. *If giving cash*, place donation in an envelope on which you have written O.C.C. Fund and place the

envelope in the offering plate. *If writing a check*, make the check payable to Clarendon Baptist Church, write O.C.C. Fund on the memo line, and place in the offering plate. (*Monetary donations are listed as tax-deductible contributions on the end-of-year statements.*)

If one family donated just \$5 a month to the O.C.C. Fund from February through October, it would be enough money to fill/pack shoeboxes for 4 children.

We need you – God needs you – to help share “**Jesus Loves You**” to these children and their families.
