2. Camp Store Cash (*If not prepaid. \$40 is the suggested amount. Put cash in envelope with name & amount on it.*)
3. \$17 for Paintball (*If not prepaid. Teen Camp Only*)
4. Final Camp payment (*If not prepaid.*)
